



national science week 2013

National Science Week is being held from Saturday 10 August to Sunday 18 August 2013.

The aim of National Science Week is to increase the awareness and understanding of the role of science, technology and innovation in everyday life and our future.

The National Science Week NT Coordination Committee (NatSciWk NT CC) receives funding from the Commonwealth Department of Industry, Innovation, Science, Research and Tertiary Education (DIISRTE) – Inspiring Australia Section to coordinate National Science Week in the NT. Of this funding, the NatSciWk NT CC has allocated up to \$7000 (maximum of \$2000 for any event) for grants to community groups to assist with the running of an event during National Science Week 2013.

GUIDELINES FOR APPLICANTS FILLING OUT THE 2013 GRANT APPLICATION FORM

Contact details

Applicant's Name

The name of the person / officer responsible for the grant application and for the project should the application be successful.

Organisation

For an organisation or company it must have a registered name. ABN numbers should be supplied where applicable.

Postal address / Physical address / Phone / Facsimile and E-mail address

Contact details for the applicant. The provision of a facsimile number and/or e-mail address will ensure immediate acknowledgement of receipt of application.

Signature

The applicant's signature (on hardcopy applications)

The Questions

1. Title of Proposal or Activity

The title of the proposal or activity should be short and attention grabbing. Please use this same title for all National Science Week matters. The activity **must** be registered under this name online at www.scienceweek.net.au before **COB Thursday 1st August 2013**.

2. Total amount of Funding Requested

The full amount of funding that is being sought from this grant.

- The **maximum amount** available per event is **\$2000**, the minimum amount is **\$500**.
- The allocation of all grants is subject to how effectively the application fulfils the selection criteria listed below.
- The Grants Committee **may only grant an event a percentage** of what was requested, if it is deemed that is the maximum amount that is required to successfully conduct the proposed activity. It must be ensured that only the funds that are really needed to conduct the event are sought.
- The Grants Committee will calculate the Goods and Services Tax (GST) applicable to the grants. Hence your funding proposal should be GST exclusive.

3. National Science Week Grant Outcomes

Describe the intended outcomes and achievements of the project and how these outcomes meet the NT National Science Week and DIISRTE objectives stipulated in the selection criteria listed below.

4. Description of National Science Week proposal or activity

This should be a short description of what the project is, what it involves and who it involves. It should give clear details of the event being proposed. It is important that the Grants Committee can clearly understand what is being planned so as to determine whether this will enable the stated outcomes above to be achieved.

5. Target Groups and Reach

Detail the target audience and the geographical coverage of the project. Target audience could be children, secondary students, industry leaders, or the general public. The geographical coverage, for example, could be Katherine, Tennant Creek or Oenpelli. In addition stipulate the estimated number of people reached by the proposed event.

6. Project Timeframe

Projects must be completed during National Science Week 2013, 10th-18th August or as part of an associated National Science Week event to be considered for the grant. Actual date/s of the proposed event should be stipulated.

7. Budget

A detailed budget must be included. The budget should outline how the grant funds will be expended (e.g. venue hire, travel costs, equipment hire, advertising etc) and what contribution is to be made by the applicant's organisation and any other sources. The more detailed the budget submission the easier it will be for the Grants Committee to see the merit of the proposed event. Selection Criteria

A merit-based process will be used to select projects for financial support. All applications must meet the following selection criteria:

1. The project must be consistent with the NT National Science Week and DIISRTE objectives

The objective of the NatSciWk NT CC and DIISRTE is to increase awareness and understanding of the central role which science, technology, innovation and entrepreneurship play in Australia's economic and social wellbeing.

2. Target/Reach

Proposals should indicate the **geographical and institutional reach**.

3. The project should be conducted during National Science Week 2013 or as part of an associated National Science Week 2013 event

In 2013 National Science Week will be held from 10 -18 August. Support will only be offered to projects being held during this time or as part of an associated National Science Week 2013 event.

4. The project must be innovative and value for money.

The Grants Committee are particularly interested in proposals that have a new or refreshing approach to meeting the National Science Week objectives and achieving value for money.

5. The project must detail the overall budget.

A budget including details of finance or other resources provided by the applicant's organisation and other organisations should be included.

Miscellaneous Items

GST and Grants

The Goods and Services Tax (GST) is generally applicable to grants. If successful in this grant round, you will need to supply the Department with your Australian Business Number (ABN) if you/your

organisation has a gross income that exceeds \$50 000 pa (for profit) or \$100 000 (not for profit). It is your responsibility to check with the Australian Taxation Office on this matter to ensure that you have an ABN if required. Failure to supply an ABN when it is required may result in the withholding 48.5% of the value of the grant.

Public Liability

The grant recipient shall effect and maintain insurance where applicable and if, requested shall provide the NScWk NT with a copy of the policy or policies as the case may be.

Activities that will not be funded

Given the limited availability of funding, only those costs, which are directly involved in the relevant project, can be supported. Infrastructure and support costs such as general administration and salaries are the responsibility of the applicant. Research projects will not be funded, nor will conferences, lectures or seminars that are not specific to National Science Week.

Obligations of successful applicants

Successful applicants **MUST**:

- Register the event online at www.scienceweek.net.au by **COB Thursday 1st August 2013**.
- Sign a written deed, and note that progress on the project will be monitored.
- Provide confirmed event details to publicity/promotions representative of the NatSciWk NT committee by Friday 28 June 2013 for printed publications and promotions. (failure to meet this deadline will exclude your event from the publicity & promotions provided by the NatSciWk NT CC)
- Complete an online evaluation at www.scienceweek.net.au by **C.O.B Friday 20 September 2013**.
- Submit final reports and acquittal forms to a standard acceptable to the NatSciWk NT Committee by **C.O.B Friday 20 September 2013**.
- Acknowledge the Commonwealth Government and the NT National Science Week Coordinating Committee in their promotions and publicity. Logos can be found on the [National Science Week Website](http://www.scienceweek.net.au)

It is expected that applicants will be advised of their application's outcome by Friday 19th April 2013.

The application must be lodged with the NatSciWk NT CC Grants Committee by **C.O.B Friday 5th April 2013**.
