**Create a science poster to share an idea around a science topic of your choice.**

**A successful science poster entry has:**

- has accurate science content
- will communicate the single idea clearly
- will show good quality drawing, artistic skills and imagination, giving the poster visual appeal

**Entry guidelines:**

- All diagrams must be the student's own work.
- Hand draw or produce diagrams using tools on a computer.

**The poster should:**

- be approximately A2 in size (42 cm x 59 cm – double A3)
- not have any built-up or three-dimensional sections
- not contain any glitter.
