Whether you're a cat owner, wildlife lover, or just want to support your community—you can help. Together, let's build a safer place for cats, people, and wildlife alike!



Here's how you can help:

- **log sightings** of roaming or stray cats using the free FeralScan app
- **spread the word** by encouraging neighbours and friends to participate
- **record regularly** – more data equals more meaningful insights
- **keep your cat safe at home** to protect them from injury, illness or getting lost—and to reduce their impact on wildlife.

By recording sightings, you'll be contributing to broader efforts to protect Darwin's wildlife and cats. Sighting data will be used to inform local education and awareness initiatives, and shared with the Northern Territory Government, which is responsible for managing feral animal populations.
