

1. About the Competition

The AIP-ACT Branch Photography Competition is hosted by the Australian Institute of Physics – Australian Capital Territory (AIP-ACT) Branch Committee (email: actbranch@aip.org.au). By entering, you agree to follow the following rules.

2. Who Can Enter

The Competition is open to anyone who currently resides in Australia. An Australian bank account is also required to transfer funds in the event that a prize is awarded. Entrants under 18 years of age must have parent or guardian consent to enter.

3. Entry Period

The Competition remains open as long as the online form is open.

4. How to Enter

Submit your entry by filling out the online form. Multiple registrations are allowed and you can submit multiple photos in one registration. There is no fee to register.

5. Photo Guidelines

All photos must be your own original work. You must own all copyright rights to the photos you submit. Photos must not contain any illegal or offensive content. If people are visible in your photo, you must have their permission to feature them.

6. Judging and Prizes

Entries will be judged by the AIP-ACT Branch Committee. Photos will be judged on relevance to physics and artistic merit. The judges' decision is final. Winners will be notified via the registered email within a month of the closing date.

7. Use of Photos

You keep the copyright to your photos. If you win the Competition, you grant the AIP a non-exclusive license to use your submitted photos to promote the Competition and the AIP on the website, social media channels, newsletters, and events.

8. Privacy

The AIP will collect your personal information (like your name and email) to run the Competition and contact winners. We will not share your personal information with third parties without your permission.
